# Why Warranties Matter

Flooring warranties aren't just legal fine print—they're your first line of defense against unexpected costs. They cover everything from manufacturing defects to installation errors, but most come with strict requirements. One missed step can void your coverage and leave you footing the bill.

This guide explains how to stay compliant, avoid common pitfalls, and plan smarter for long-term performance.



# The 3 Types of Flooring Warranties



#### **PRODUCT WARRANTY**

Covers manufacturing defects like wear-through or delamination. Issued by the flooring manufacturer.

#### **ADHESIVE WARRANTY**

Covers bonding issues and chemical breakdown - often dependent on surface prep and moisture conditions.



#### INSTALLATION/WORKMANSHIP WARRANTY

Covers improper install methods (e.g., misaligned seams, poor leveling). Typically provided by the flooring contractor.



## What's Covered (and What's Not)



#### **TYPICAL WARRANTY COVERAGE:**

- Manufacturing defects (e.g., surface wear, delamination)
- Product failure under normal commercial use
- Workmanship issues (if installed by certified professionals)



#### **COMMON EXCLUSIONS:**

- 💢 Improper cleaning or maintenance
- Environmental damage (e.g., moisture, UV exposure)
- X Installation by uncertified contractors
- Failure to maintain proper temperature/humidity levels

#### **SKIPPING MOISTURE TESTING**

No ASTM-compliant tests = no protection. Even new slabs can hold damaging vapor.

#### **IMPROPER MAINTENANCE**

Using the wrong cleaning products or neglecting care guidelines can kill your warranty.

#### **LACK OF DOCUMENTATION**

Most warranties require proof of installation conditions, testing, and ongoing maintenance.



## How to Maintain Your Warranty Coverage



#### **BEFORE INSTALLATION:**

- Confirm manufacturer-approved products and adhesives
- Conduct/document moisture
- testing (ASTM F2170/F1869)
- Maintain proper environmental conditions (temperature, humidity)



#### **DURING INSTALLATION:**

- Hire a certified flooring contractor
- Use approved installation techniques and materials
- Take site photos and collect OA/OC documentation



#### **AFTER INSTALLATION:**

- Follow manufacturer's
- maintenance schedule
- Use only approved cleaning agents
- Keep logs of all maintenance activity



## GC & Facility Manager Tips

#### **COORDINATE EARLY**


Confirm the building is enclosed and HVAC systems are operational before installation.

#### **DON'T RUSH IT**


Installing before curing is complete or before other trades finish (like drywall or plumbing) can void your warranty.

#### **ASK ABOUT SITE INSPECTIONS**

Some warranties require manufacturer approval or site inspections before coverage kicks in.



### Documentation for Claims



of a warranty claim:

**ASTM** moisture test reports

Installation date, crew, and product batch numbers

**Environmental** conditions during install

Photos of slab prep and finished work

Post-install cleaning and maintenance records
